Primary Coach of at least: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 6 swimmers compete in individual events at Australian Swimming Champs since receiving Silver Coach; or 4 individual swimmers achieve an Australian Long Course Final (Olympic events); or 2 individual medallists in an Australian Long Course Final (Olympic events); or 1 individual swimmer selected in an Australian Open Team. <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Team coach on the Australian Team at a Paralympics or Para World Champs and be the primary coach of an athlete on the team; or Primary coach of an athlete who achieves a world record in a recognised Paralympic games event <p>OR</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Primary coach of an athlete who achieves selection on the Australian Open Water Swimming Team in the 10k event at the FINA World Champs and/or the Olympic Games;

***Primary Coach** means that at least 85% of each swimmer's training program is directly planned and supervised by the Coach claiming credit for that performance for a period of at least 90 days prior to the competition in which the performance was achieved.*

Note: Coaches who have consistently developed high quality and successful swimmers who have moved onto other coaches or achieve commendable results in remote areas may also apply for Silver with details of the athletes they have coached and their successes. These applications will be assessed by a sub-committee of the ASCTA Board.
